BSA WINS 250-MILE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP ENDURANCE RUN

VICTOR 441 SPECIAL RIDDEN
BY JOHN YOUNG BEATS BIG FIELD
OF TOP ENDURO ACES.

Columbus, Ohio, May 29: A new enduro champion made the news in the 1966 "Little Burr" 250 Mile National Championship Endurance Run held over tough terrain in central Ohio. John Young, Alsip, Ill. riding his new BSA Victor 441 Special led the way throughout the arduous grind, finished with 987 points to emerge Grand Champion.

A coming champion, Young had finished in second place in the 175 Mile National Championship Enduro held May 1 near Sterling, Illinois riding the same Victor 441 Special.

In the 250, John beat out such well known former champions as John Penton, Bill Baird, LeRoy Winters, and a host of top-ranking Enduro riders.
