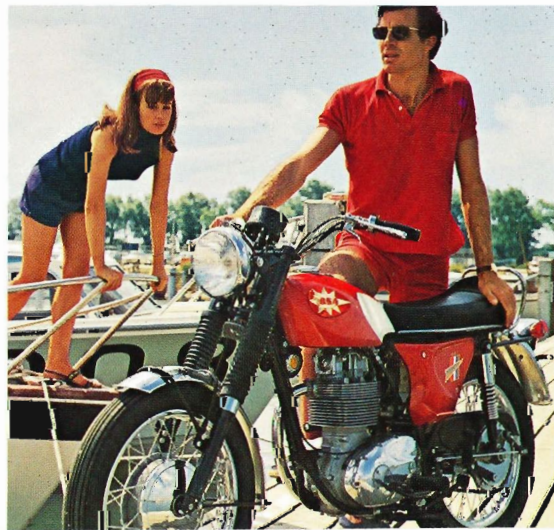




BSA SHOOTING STAR 441 441cc Alloy Single



This is the big single that goes like a rocket.

This is what happens when you take the lightweight frame of the Starfire (see opposite page) and you mate it to the famous BSA 441cc engine. Then, further *increase* the high performance of this famous engine . . . and you get the Shooting Star, a brand new member of the bold new world of BSA.

You get big power in this lightweight motorcycle with 9.5 to 1 compression, high-torque and sparkling top-end performance.

In any bike, go without adequate stop is no go. That's why the Shooting Star has a brand new full-width brake — a full 8" in diameter.

Starting is easier with new longer kick of the lever.

Other reasons for the whoosh of the Shooting Star: aluminum cylinder barrel and head, for keeping cool — iron liner for long, long wear. Styling and finish that say "now" and "class".
